Sabemos que los adjetivos comparativos nos ayudan a comparar dos personas, cosas o animales pero existen otros adjetivos

llamados:

SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES.

The superlative form is used to compare one thing to all the others in the same category; in other words, when the comparison is taken to the highest degree possible, for example:



1. Gloria is the **FATTEST** animal in the group. (Gloria es el animal más gordito en el grupo)
2. Melman is the **TALLEST** in the picture. (Melman is el más alto en la foto.)
3. Private is the **FUNNIEST** penguin. (Private es el pingüino más divertido.)
4. Skipper is **THE MOST INTELLIGENT PENGUIN** in Madagascar. (Skipper es el pingüino más inteligente de Madagascar)

ES DECIR SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES DESCRIBEN UNA CUALIDAD EXTREMA DE UNA PERSONA, ANIMAL O COSA SOBRE UN GRUPO, TAL CUAL LO VISUALIZA EN EL DIBUJO, SE DESCRIBE AL MEJOR EN ALGÚN ASPECTO.

Para transformar un adjetivo a superlative tomar en cuenta las siguientes reglas:

Formation of Superlative Adjectives

As with comparative adjectives, there are two ways to form a superlative adjective:

- short adjectives: add "-est"
- long adjectives: use "most"

We also usually add 'the' at the beginning.

Short adjectives

1-syllable adjectives

old, fast



Short adjectives

2-syllable adjectives ending in -y

happy, easy

RULE: add "-est"

old → the oldest

Variation: if the adjective ends in -e, just add -st

late → the latest

Variation: if the adjective ends in consonant, vowel, consonant, double the last consonant

big → the biggest

Variation: if the adjective ends in -y, change the y to i

happy → the happiest

Long adjectives

2-syllable adjectives not ending in -y

modern, pleasant

all adjectives of 3 or more syllables

expensive, intellectual

RULE: use "most"

modern → the most modern
expensive → the most expensive

With some 2-syllable adjectives, we can use "-est" *OR* "most":

quiet → the quietest/most quiet

clever → the cleverest/most clever

narrow → the narrowest/most narrow

simple → the simplest/most simple

Exception: The following adjectives have irregular forms:

- good → the best
- bad → the worst
- far → the farthest/furthest

EXAMPLES:





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The man is the strongest person in the picture.

The child is the youngest person in the picture..

The teacher is the best-looking person in the picture.
