	WRITE EXAMPLES OF THE RULES FOR USING THE PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS
	1: To say how long for unfinished actions which started in the past and continue to the present.
	Examples:
•	I've been living in London for two years.
•	She's been working here since 2004.
	••••••
	2: For temporary habits or situations. The action started in the past and continues to the present in the same way as with use number 1, but we don't answer the questions about 'how long' so clearly. Instead,
	we use a word like 'recently'.
•	I've been going to the gym a lot recently.
•	They've been living with his mother while they look for a house.



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3: Actions which have recently stopped (though the whole action can be unfinished) and have a result, which we can often see, hear, or feel, in the present. We don't use a time word here.

I'm so tired, I've been studying. I've been running, so I'm really hot.
